- Turn off all appliances when not in use, such as TVs, stereos, coffee pots, fans, radios, chargers, classroom projectors, etc.

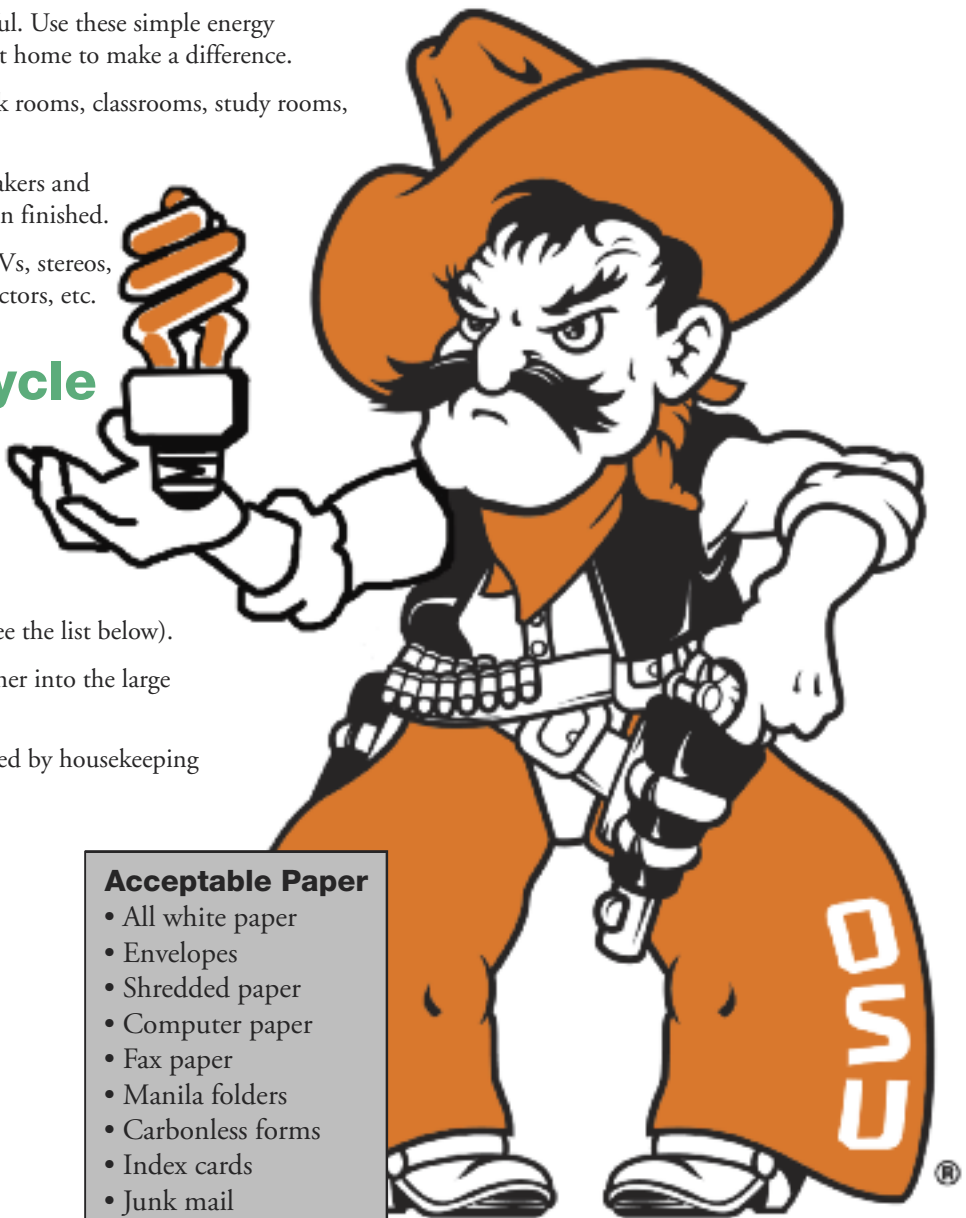

OSU's faculty and staff in Tulsa can participate paper recycling by following these steps:

- Place your personal recycling container in a convenient location – perhaps under your desk or next to your printer.
- Fill your container with acceptable paper items (see the list below).
- At your convenience, empty your personal container into the large collection bin closest to your department.
- The centralized containers will be regularly emptied by housekeeping staff and delivered to recycling centers.
